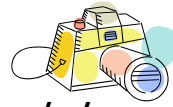


Healthy Eating Please bring healthy lunchboxes and fruit and vegetables only for snack. Fizzy drinks are not allowed thank you.

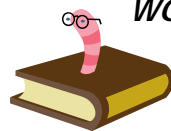
